HOW YOUR ORGANIZATION COULD GET INVOLVED?

Driving #ENOUGH participation in the communities you serve: Leveraging your existing relationships, you can help spread the reach of #ENOUGH immensely and in ways that will increase the depth and breadth of the conversation around gun violence. Agreeing to help share #ENOUGH via social media, through your media contacts, and to your subscriber base directly will ensure that the youth in your community have a chance to get their voice heard.

Programming #ENOUGH amidst your pre-existing theatre education activities: Our goal is not to tax your already strapped organization at all. That's why #ENOUGH is a kind of 'choose your own adventure' kind of program. Are there ways this program could fold into or augment pre-existing education / playwriting programs your organization currently implements? Perhaps you already participate in young playwriting competitions and facilitate workshops in schools for them. #ENOUGH can piggyback on those kinds of opportunities. Or maybe you have the ability to facilitate a whole host of axillary activities around #ENOUGH and really galvanize conversation in your community. How and to what degree you want/are able to participate is up to you - but know that any participation is better than none!

Hosting a flagship Nationwide Reading of #ENOUGH on December 14, 2020: While our main focus is for middle and high schools host these readings to spark conversation in their specific communities, we're interested in professional theaters across the country to host **Flagship Readings** of #ENOUGH. Think of Flagship Readings as an opportunity for students from different communities to gather on your stage and where your organization can invite some key players - policy makers, advocates, etc. - to listen and respond to the plays and join the conversation. This is how we take action.

Contribute to our Facilitation / Discussion Guide: The **Facilitation / Discussion/ Guide** will go out in Fall 2020, to inform reading hosts how to organize / stage their reading, how to have a conversation afterwards, and what to do now that a conversation has been had with a call to action. Think of it like a study guide for the program that supports the important conversations that will be happening all over the country. *Our goal is that this Guide be designed in collaboration among a handful of theatre companies and attributed to those companies.*
